Derby Choral Union is one of the UK's longest-running choral societies, established in 1866. We hold three concerts each year, performing a wide range of choral works from the Baroque period right up to the present day.

Despite losing public funding in recent years we have managed to increase our membership, raise audience levels and maintain our standards. This has been achieved through a range of measures including fund raising from within the choir but we have also had to make some sacrifices.

We have some ambitious aspirations over the coming years as we pass our 150th year and lay the foundations for the next chapter in the choir's history.

Our five-year aims include:

- ✓ To grow our membership and continue the trend of welcoming younger singers to the choir.
- ✓ To explore larger venues for our concerts in order to accommodate our expanding membership and audience base.
- ✓ To raise our performance budget by 50% to ensure orchestral accompaniment at all our concerts and soloists of even higher calibre.
- ✓ To hold regular workshops for the local community to raise awareness of music making, to attract members and increase support from a wider audience.

We cannot achieve all of these aims alone whilst retaining current standards. For the first time in the society's history we are inviting private and corporate sponsors to assist us in achieveing these objectives, with packages that offer mutually rewarding benefits.

Facts about DCU

There's much more to us than the singing. Here are some facts about Derby Choral Union you may not have realised:

- ✓ DCU started nearly 150 years ago, making us one of the longest-running choral societies in the UK.
- ✓ We have over 100 members, 10% of which are aged 35 and under. Younger members are our fastest growing membership sector, in part thanks to increased media coverage of choirs in recent years.
- ✓ Members aged 25 and under are awarded a Choral Scholarship and do not have to pay any membership fees. We also allow accompanied children under 16 free entry to our concerts and give all other students a 50% discount.
- We act as a familiar friend and rewarding activity for our members, some of whom have been with us for over 40 years!
- ✓ It costs on average £4,500 to hold each concert, including venue hire, professional soloists, accompaniment and performance licences.
- ✓ We distribute over 13,000 items of printed materials each year including programmes, posters, leaflets and concert guides. This represents a great opportunity for you to promote your brand across the county all year round.
- ✓ As much as 1/3rd of our ticket revenue is now generated from online ticket sales, proving we are rejuvenating and growing our audience base.
